UWP Foundation board elects new leaders

Kenosha area residents Timothy T. Mahone and S.R. Mills were recently elected officers of the University of Wisconsin-Parkside Foundation board of trustees.

Mahone will serve as board president, while Mills will serve as secretary. Also elected were Thomas G. Marini, treasurer, and Emily Lawrence, vice president.
